The time of year is upon us when we begin to make plans for next year. Here are some answers to questions we are frequently asked at this time of year.

Can I make a request for my child's teacher?

Requests for a certain teacher will generally not be considered because this does not allow us the ability to create groupings that take all of our students' needs into account. The development of homeroom class lists is a complicated process. Efforts are made to ensure that each class is balanced academically and socially. We also try to mix classes from year to enable children the opportunity to develop new friendships. We group students and only assign a teacher to each group at the end of the process, when we believe each class make-up is well-balanced. These decisions are made very carefully by considering the best learning situation for all of our children.

If there are social or other factors that you would like us to know when assigning your child to a class grouping, please share that information with your child's teacher as soon as possible so it can be considered when building homeroom lists.

When does my child pick junior high options?

A quick list is compiled by asking students which options they would like. This will happen in the next few weeks. Their choices are not finalized until parents approve them. Please discuss the option choices with your child as options **will not** be switched part-way through the year without extenuating circumstances. Classes are composed to balance numbers over the year and we expect that students will complete the options that they chose.
